

Kern Branch MTAC Dress Code Guidelines

Performers at all events will abide by the following:

Young Ladies:

Skirts or dresses that fall no more than two inches above the knee when seated. Dressy pants are an acceptable alternative. No shorts, jeans, leggings or skirts with high slits.

Blouses or tops should not be revealing. No bare midriffs (tummy or lower back), spaghetti straps or tank tops. Outerwear must cover your underwear.

Dress shoes are preferred, avoid heels higher than 2-2 ½ inches. Shoes should stay on the foot when walking. No flip-flop sandals or athletic styles.

Young Men:

Dress Shirt: tucked in, button up and with a collar. Polo shirts are acceptable. Sport Coat, Suit Jackets and/or ties are always appropriate. No sweatshirts, hoodies, t-shirts or tank tops.

Dress Slacks or 'Dockers' are preferred. No shorts, jeans or sloppy/baggy pants.

Dress shoes are preferred. No flip-flop sandals, or slides.

All Performers:

Dress Clothes are preferred.

Avoid distracting accessories, including excessive jewelry or hats, which might interfere with your own performance.

Hair should be worn in a manner that keeps hair out of your eyes and away from your face. Avoid any extreme hair colors or styles.

Clean hands with nails trimmed.

Candy and chewing gum are not allowed at recitals.
