## MONTHLY BRANCH MEETING

Our next monthly meeting will be next week, Thursday, January 13 at 9:30 on Zoom. An Agenda will be emailed to each member a couple days before the meeting. The Zoom ID and Passcode will be at the top of the Agenda.

## **CERTIFICATE OF MERIT – IMPORTANT INFORMATION -- Repertoire Deadline**

As you know, CM is coming sooner than usual – about a month earlier! You can post or change the repertoire until January 15. If it's already posted, but if there has been a change in repertoire, be sure to make the change in the Teacher Portal. If repertoire is not listed, the student will be deleted from CM. If you have successfully completed the repertoire section, the orange box on the CM List will show Media Required. If it still shows Incomplete, you may have not listed which is the Syllabus piece. Or if you selected one of the pieces to be judged for Convention, you may need to add the timing of the piece. The videos and scanned music may be added anytime starting now through the CM window of February 12-21.

Students will make a video of each piece when it is memorized (2 must be memorized) and polished. The CM Council recommends that the teachers view each video to be sure it is a good performance. Parents can then post the video in the Parent Portal. Parents/Students will post separate videos of each of their pieces as well as the Technique Chart (using only the "clean" technique chart during the videotaping [the chart only with no printing at the bottom] -- available in the Parent Portal or in the Teacher Portal). Music will need to be scanned to upload to the CM page as well. Be sure to scan the front cover of the book or sheet music AND the printed music with all pages in one pdf scan. PHOTOS OF THE PAGES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE – THEY DO NOT SHOW THE CLEARLY. USE AN APP THAT SCANS WITH YOUR PHONE. Be sure to number the first measure of each line on all music before it is scanned.

## IF YOUR STUDENT WANTS TO PERFORM AT THE 2022 CONVENTION...

The teacher must indicate online in the CM application which piece is to be rated for possible Convention performance by January 15.

There are 4 recital choices for Convention performance:

- 1. The Convention <u>Theme Recitals</u> will be music by composers born in the last 125 years (since 1897). The time limit for the Theme Recital is 7 minutes. This is for Level 3 and above.
- 2. The Convention <u>Festival Recitals</u> will be the piece that is listed on their application as the Syllabus piece for level 3 and above.

- 3. The Convention <u>New Materials Recitals</u> is for the contemporary piece that was published in the last 10 years. This is for Level 1 and above.
- 4. The Convention <u>Ensemble Recitals</u> are for students Level 3 and above who played a piece with 2 or more performers.

## MORE CM INFO...

Teachers, did you know you can click on "reports," just above your list of CM students to print a list of your students, either with or without their repertoire?

This year there are **Practice Tests** available online in the Parent Portal for all students enrolled in CM. The Tests are available for Theory and Sightreading. Students will take PRACTICE TESTS in the Parent Portal and get Immediate scores. These are available now. Students may take one Theory Test and one Sightreading Test per day. The parent (or teacher) can click on the box that says "Send Link to Student". Teacher can click on "Details" after each test to see what the student missed. If you need help, you are welcome to contact Dorothy.

### **BACH FESTIVAL**


